

MICHELLE RODRIGUEZ DOMINATES ALL OTHER CANDIDATES IN FUNDRAISING IN AD 53

Mother of deputy sheriff, firefighter and healthcare worker has raised \$222,000 and has more cash-on-hand than all other candidates combined

(Pomona, CA) Campaign finance reports filed by the July 31, 2023 deadline reveal that Democrat Michelle Rodriguez is dominating all other candidates in both total fundraising and in cash-on-hand.

In fact, Rodriguez has raised more than all other candidates combined with \$222,365 and continues to have more cash on hand than all other candidates with \$200,387 cash on hand, and zero debt, unlike the others.
